THE THEATRE AT BOSTON COURT

The Theatre at Boston Court debuted this June with a spectacular summer of Music at the Court, featuring the best of cabaret and jazz, with a bonus Storytelling For the Whole Family sandwiched between music dates. Boston Court is a brand new, \$5 million, 11,500 square-foot performing arts complex located at 70 North Mentor Ave. at Boston Ct., just north of Colorado Blvd.

The series began with Jazz at the Court featuring The Alan Broadbent Trio, June 6 - 7, followed by The Tootie Heath Trio, June 20 and 21. Next is The Roberto Miranda Trio, July 18 and 19, and The Bill Cunliffe Trio, August 1 and 2. Cabaret at the Court debuts with Stacy Sullivan, June 13 and 14, Karen Gallinger, June 27 and 28, Cindy Benson, July 11 and 12, and Anne Kerry Ford, July 25 and 26. Storytelling, hosted by theatre owner, Z. Clark Branson, plays June 15 and July 13 and features Bill Howard, Jon Hughes, and Leslie Perry on both dates, joined by Angela Lloyd, June 15, and Nick Smith, July 13.

All Music at the Court events begin at 8 p.m., Storytelling begins at 3 p.m., and all events will be held in the 60-seat Marjorie Branson Performance Space at Boston Court. Plentiful off-street parking is available in the rear of Boston Court, and the facilities are handicapped-accessible.

Opening the Jazz at the Court series, pianist and arranger Alan Broadbent's music has been recorded by leading jazz artists and his long relationship with Concord Jazz has produced numerous top-selling LPs from his trio and in collaborations with other top jazz artists. Master drummer Tootie Heath is the youngest of the jazz royalty Heath family and has earned an outstanding reputation playing with the likes of Lester Young, John Coltrane, Wes Montgomery, and Herbie Hancock. Roberto Miranda is a dynamic bassist who has toured, played and recorded with an impressive array of the world's best jazz artists. Grammy nominated composer, arranger and jazz pianist Bill Cunliffe is gathering nationwide attention with his innovative and swinging recordings and compositions.

Stacy Sullivan, winner of the 2002 Female New York Debut award from the Manhattan Association of Cabaret and Clubs, brings songs from her new CD release West on 40 to the Cabaret at the Court series. Karen Gallinger, one of Southern California's finest jazz vocalists, is described as stylish and sultry by some critics and simply fun and irresistible by others. Cindy Benson received rave reviews from starring roles in Broadway's Cats and Les Miserables. Anne Kerry Ford also hails from Broadway, but has become known as a consummate cabaret singer playing major U.S. clubs.

Lastly, Storytelling for the Whole Family features two afternoons of live storytelling from accomplished, well-loved raconteurs doing ancient and contemporary pieces from around the world.
